School Improvement Plan (Goal Updates):

The 2021-2022 SIP Goals were presented. The goals for the 21-22 SIP were developed based on the final Progress Monitoring Activity (PMA). The goal for Instructional Practice specifically relating to

Professional Learning Communities remained the same as the 2020-2021 school year with the difference of increasing the Lowest 25% proficiency rate from 33% to 38% in ninth grade English Language Arts and from 38% to 43% in tenth grade English Language Arts. The second goal focusing on Culture & Environment specifically relating to Social and Emotional Learning remained the same as the 2020-2021 school year with the difference of increasing the number of students who feel connected to an adult advocate under the Student Sense of Belonging component of our annual Panorama survey from 33% to more than 40%.
